

PUBLIC NOTICE

Comal County provides certain health care services to residents of Comal County who are not eligible for any other governmental health care program, public or private insurance program and whose family income is approximately at or below 21 % of the federal poverty level.

Comal County will use the rules and procedures found in the County Indigent Health Care Program Handbook, published by the Texas Department of Health. In summary, these rules require applications to be completely filled out; verification of income or termination of income, residency, household composition and resources, if questionable.

Liquid assets cannot exceed \$2000 or \$3000 depending on household situation. The trade in value of a vehicle greater than \$4650 is counted against the resource limit. Personal property and homestead are exempt assets. The applicants **MUST** be residents of Comal County. All requested information and documentation must be provided or the application will be denied. Applicants have the right to appeal adverse decisions.

Countable income is classified as earned, which would be from employment or unearned. Unearned income sources would be Social Security income, unemployment, child support, VA benefits as examples.

Applications are available on the County Website or the Comal County Office of Indigent Health, 150 North Sequin #211, New Braunfels Monday through Friday from 8:00 to 11:30 and 1:00 to 4:30 or by telephoning 830-221-1210.
