ORDER GRANTING DISCRETIONARY EXEMPTION FROM SECTION 262.023 OF THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE FOR CAPTIVE REPLACEMENT PARTS OR COMPONENTS FOR EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, Section 262.023 of the Texas Local Government Code requires the Commissioners Court to comply with competitive bidding procedures for purchase of one or more items under a contract that will require an expenditure exceeding \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, Section 262.024(a)(7)(D) of the Texas Local Government Code authorizes the Commissioners Court to grant an exemption for an item that can be obtained from only one source including captive replacement parts or components for equipment; and

WHEREAS, Tejas Equipment, Inc. is the only one source where captive replacement parts or components for equipment can be obtained for the repair of the Recycling Shredder;

WHEREAS, Comal County wishes to procure captive replacement parts or components for equipment from Tejas Equipment, Inc. for the repair of the Recycling Shredder;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FOR COMAL COUNTY THAT: The provisions of Texas Local Government Code §262.024(a)(7)(D) shall apply to exempt the procurement with Tejas Equipment, Inc. for the procurement of captive replacement parts or components from the competitive bidding procedures.
