The Comal County Sheriff's Office is proud to announce its Junior Deputy Academy Program for the summer of 2010. This year's camps are scheduled at three school campuses in an effort to bring the camps to three geographic areas of the county. Camp times are from 8am to 12pm Monday through Friday. There is no charge for your child attending (Donations are gratefully accepted).

The program is open to boys and girls 9 to 11 years of age, the academy gives the children a chance to interact with Sheriffs Deputies and make friends with positive role models.

Deputies from the various parts of the Sheriff's Office will visit with the children and introduce them to the different functions they provide, some of which some are: Patrol, SWAT, Crisis Negotiations, Honor Guard, Criminal Investigations, Crime Prevention, 911 Emergency Center, Narcotics Drug Awareness, along with the Fire Department and EMS, Air life and Public Utilities.

On Wednesday of each camp, the children will tour the Sheriff's Office, Detention Facility, Communications (911) Center, Criminal Investigations, Warrant Office and Patrol Center. The children will also meet with Sheriff Bob Holder. Transportation from the campsite will be provided by Comal Independent School District for the field day at the Comal County Sheriff's Office

All children will receive a T-Shirt and Graduation Certificate.

If your child would like to attend, please fill out the application on the back of this page and return it as soon as possible. Applications for the 1st camp will be accepted until May 26, 2010. Deadline to turn in applications for the 2nd camp will be June 7, 2010, for the 3rd camp will be July 7, 2010.

Have your children wear comfortable clothing (shorts etc.) and tennis shoes. We will be playing some games etc. so we prefer no sandals or flip flops.

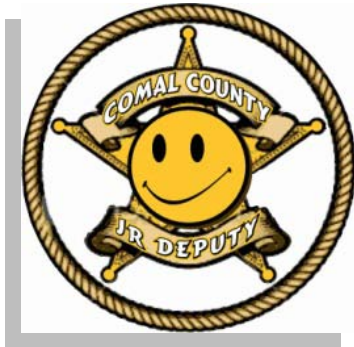
Unruly behavior will not be tolerated and if any child becomes a disciplinary problem, parents will be called and he or she will be sent home.

Graduation will be at 11:00AM on Friday and parents are encouraged to attend. The program will last approx.45 minutes, and we have found that the children really enjoy having their parents, grandparents, and others in attendance.
